10 Days for the Church

Day 1 Repentance

Joel 2:12-13 *Now, therefore, says the LORD, Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning. So rend your heart, and not your garments; return to the LORD your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm.*

Romans 2:4 *Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and long-suffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?*

Hosea 6:1-3, 6; 2 Corinthians 7:9,10

PRAYER:

Father God, we acknowledge that You are holy and righteous, so we come and bow our hearts before You. We praise You that You are compassionate and have given us access to come before Your throne. It is Your kindness that draws us to repentance as Your Word declares, so we thank You for extending Your lovingkindness to us today. Allow us to see our sin for what it is and be sorrowful for it, because it separates us from You and cost the life of Your only begotten Son. We pray this not only for ourselves, but for our nation. O God, how we have offended You. We repent on behalf of our nation, our leaders and citizens alike. May we recognize our offenses and turn away from them to You who are willing to forgive and restore. May we walk in humility and gratitude, and perform deeds appropriate to repentance. Father, thank You for Your grace and mercy which is provided new for us today.

*Because of Your grace, I ask You to forgive me for any way that I have grieved You or Your Holy Spirit. Help me to hear Your voice as I bring to mind these things. Forgive me, Father, for I have sinned against You and my people in the following ways..._____ (listen and obey!). I ask You to cleanse me from this unrighteousness and renew a right spirit within me. Show me how to respond in my world to make this attitude and my relationships right. It is in the all-powerful name of Jesus our Lord and Savior we pray. Amen.

Day 2 Praise and Thanksgiving

***Psalm 100:1-5** Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. Know that the LORD, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, And His truth endures to all generations.*

***Ephesians 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in heavenly places ...to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.*

Psalm 103; Ephesians 1:3-11

PRAYER:

Lord God, we lift our hearts in thanksgiving and praise to You, for You are God alone and worthy of all praise. We bless Your name for You are good. You are the One who made us; we are Yours and therefore live for You. May our lips speak great joy and our service be given with gladness. Hear the joyful songs of our hearts that honor You as we meditate on Your everlasting lovingkindness and faithfulness to every generation. When we are weighed down by the burdens of sin and the cares of this life, draw our hearts back to You. Lift our eyes to see Your glory that we may praise You in a way that is worthy of Your name. We are so blessed by Your marvelous, amazing grace! May our lives show our gratitude for each of these blessings that are ours in abundance.

*And now, Lord, I thank You for the many blessings in my life! _____
(name them!) Fill my heart with thankfulness every day, that brings glory to You! Lord Jesus I live to praise the glory of Your grace! Amen

Day 3 Attitudes and Actions

Proverbs 3:5-8 *Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil. It will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones.*

Hebrews 12:1-3 *Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls.*

Philippians 2:3-16

PRAYER:

Lord, You call us in Your Word to “Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than (our)selves” and to “not merely look out for (our) own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.” Then You call us up to the highest example: “Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,” and highlight His humility in becoming a man and being obedient even to the point of dying on the cross. All of our sinful attitudes seem so petty in comparison.

*Forgive me Lord for taking Your sacrifice so lightly, and for all of the things I have done that put myself before You. Help me keep my eyes on You so that not only what I do, but what I say and think will be in gratitude for Your great sacrifice that purchased my redemption. Lord, bring to mind the areas of my life that distract me. _____ (Listen, repent and obey). Strengthen me, Lord, so that I will not give in to the temptations that would ensnare me. Set me free from the bondage of wrong attitudes and actions so that I may not just walk, but “run with endurance the race that is set before me, looking to You, the author and finisher of my faith.” In the name of Jesus, our living Savior, I pray. Amen.

Day 4 Salvation through Christ

John 1:12-13 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

John 17:3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

John 3:16-18; Romans 10:8-13; 2 Peter 1:2-8

PRAYER:

Father in heaven, I thank You that by receiving You I have been given the right to be Your child. It is by Your will and no other that we are born again to eternal life through believing in Your name and who You are: Creator, Redeemer, Savior, Lord, God. Thank You, Father, for providing everything I need to have eternal life: to know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, Your only begotten Son, whom You sent to be our Savior. Thank you, Jesus for coming to show us the Father's love, and not only living a perfect life but being the perfect sacrifice to take away the sins of the whole world, including my sins. And not only did You die, but You were buried and raised up and exalted to the highest place at the right hand of the throne of God as Lord of all.

*As Lord of my life, Jesus, I yield to Your authority over every area of my life, and I submit to Your control. Show me areas in my life that I need to submit to you: _____ (listen and obey!) I repent and turn from all my sins and want to be obedient to all You have commanded. And as I do, I thank You, that You give me Your Spirit to empower me to do it. Live in me in the fullest way possible so that Your life may be seen in me and that others are drawn to know and trust You also. Use me Lord in Your Kingdom, however You choose. I am Yours. In the name of Jesus I pray. Amen.

Day 5 Broken Relationships

Isaiah 58:11-12 The LORD will guide you continually, and satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; You shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. Those from among you Shall build the old waste places; You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In.

Luke 15:11-32; Colossians 3:12-17

PRAYER:

Father God, You declare in Your Word a day in which Your people will “rebuild the ancient ruins...raise up the age-old foundations...be called the repairer of the breach, the restorer of the paths in which to dwell.” Lord, we want to be those people! To do that, we need You to continually guide us and give strength so that we will be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water whose waters do not fail. For all those who have been wounded and fallen away, for those who have felt unloved and unappreciated, for all the offended and broken-hearted, Lord we pray for their healing and restoration. Give us wisdom and courage to lovingly help the healing process and restore relationships, bringing children back to safety in You. We pray for all the prodigal sons and daughters to return to You. Guard and guide them back home. Lord, Your Word says You “run” to receive them, when they are far off. Prepare us to receive them as You do; to love, encourage, and bless them with the Father’s love.

*In Your kindness Lord, please show me any areas of offense, unloving attitudes and actions that have contributed to brokenness. Lead me to repent; forgive me; and give me grace to forgive and love as You do. As You reveal anything in this regard, I am listening: _____ (listen and obey!) I want to be faithful in obedience to You. I pray for courage to do the right thing in Your love. In Jesus name, Amen.

Day 6 Entrapments of the Age

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

1 John 4:1-6; 2 Corinthians 10:4-5; Ephesians 6:10-20

PRAYER:

O Lord, our God, how great Thou art! When we look around us today we see many counterfeits, impostors, and deceivers, all designed to destroy Your people and plan. Yet we know You are greater! Help us keep our eyes on You, then we can see the deceptions clearly for what they are. Expose the New Age Spirituality and Wiccan ideologies and all other false religions set up in opposition to Truth. Cause us to have a greater hunger and thirst for You and Your Word which alone can satisfy. May we be diligent like the Bereans and full of grace and truth like Jesus. You have equipped and empowered us with a whole arsenal; help us use it wisely and diligently, not shrinking back or losing ground. Your TRUTH prepares us for what is to come, Your RIGHTEOUSNESS envelopes us with protection, Your GOSPEL OF PEACE is that upon which we stand, our FAITH is a protective shield, Your SALVATION guards our minds, Your Word is our weapon when activated by Your Spirit, and PRAYER our engagement in the battle. Lord, keep us alert and persevering that Your Word will go forth and prevail.

*Lord God, I ask that You expose the lies, the subtle schemes of the enemy that have crept into my life. _____ (Listen and obey!) Forgive me for participation in anything of the darkness; search my heart for any deception. Cleanse me from all unrighteousness. Do this also for the Church. We thank You and praise You, in the name of Jesus our Lord, Amen.

Day 7 Strongholds in Our Land

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you a hope and a future.

John 10:10 I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

- **Suicide:** Our County's suicide rate is the third-highest in the state with a rate of 28.2 per 100,000. Oregon ranks 7th highest in the nation at 15.7 per 100,000. There are more deaths from suicide in Oregon than deaths from car crashes.
- **Drug and alcohol abuse:** Conservative estimates reveal 1,590 people 12 or older in Our County abuse or are dependent on alcohol and are in need of treatment. Approximately 633 persons 12 or older abuse or are dependent on illicit drugs. No statistics on marijuana usage except for the 565 medical marijuana patients. There are 273 growers on 240 sites in Tillamook County.
- **Abortion:** For 2011-2013 there were 117 abortions. 18 at ages 15-17, 26 at ages 18-19, 82 at age 20+ with 74% white and 10% Hispanic. 19% didn't finish school, 42% high school grad/GED, 22% college and 6% bachelor's degree or more
- **Racial prejudice:** A Brief History of Fear and Intolerance in Tillamook County by Helen P. Hill

PRAYER:

Father, we come to You in the mighty name of Jesus Christ, King of kings and Lord of lords. We give You praise, honor and glory today for Your grace and mercy toward Your children who have given up hope for their lives and futures. Today we stand in the gap for those who are contemplating ending their lives because they cannot bear the heaviness and pain. We lift up those whose lives have been devastated by drugs or alcohol. We cry out for those in deep suffering who have had abortions or are contemplating abortion. Hear the cries of the lost and of the lives stolen. Father, there are deep wounds in our County from hatred and prejudice. Heal the despair that has occurred here, the injustice done to the Native Americans, African Americans, Hispanics and others of different racial origins. Where

there is still hidden wickedness, we ask You, Lord to uncover it so that it can be dealt with.

Father, You said, “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you a hope and a future,” but the enemy has come in to kill, steal and destroy those hopes by clouding their minds with hopeless, negative thoughts. Darkness has clouded their eyes so their hearts are weighed down with heaviness and confusion. But You have said, “I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.”

We declare Your Word that says “Let the wicked forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts, and let him return unto the Lord, and to our God, and He will abundantly pardon.” Where the enemy has come in, like a flood the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him! We see Your water rising Lord! Healing waters, floods upon the dry ground! The earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea! Let You glory cover this land!

Father, You have said to Arise, Shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. For, behold the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and His glory shall be seen upon thee. Where there has been darkness, depression, addiction, hopelessness and confusion, we say **LET THERE BE LIGHT!** Father, remove the veil, the covering over these people, command Your Light to shine in their darkness! We call forth the Church to **ARISE** and **SHINE** in our County. We stand and cry out for Your mercy and healing. We join together in one accord and bind the works of darkness over these people in Jesus' name and decree and declare **LIFE** over our land! We declare open heavens over in this place!

Father, arise in the hearts of Your people! Your love is the key! Fill us with Your Spirit! Give us beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness, that we in this County might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that You might be glorified! In Jesus Name! Amen!

Day 8 The Church

Hebrews 10:23-25 *Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.*

1 Peter 4:10-11 *As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.*

1 Corinthians 3:5-11

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, Your Word tells us not to forsake the assembling of Your people. We need this to strengthen our relationships with You and each other, to teach and be accountable to Your Word. You have called me to be an important part of Your church in my community. They are motivated to serve and care for the land and people of their communities, facing unknown risks and circumstances for which they have diligently trained, and sometimes for things they lack experience and wisdom for that they must respond to. We as a community TRUST that they will show up! They do not know what the day will bring, what fears they will have to face, and the discouragement of dealing with difficult people all day long. They see life and death in its best and worst forms. These men and women need Your divinely inspired wisdom and ability to meet every circumstance, and they need protection over the things for which they have no control. The stress from these positions can cause high rates of “burn-out”, sometimes corruption, and severe pressures on their marriages and families, so we ask that You would watch over our men and women who serve our community and beyond. Make them discerning and wise, strong and courageous, holy and righteous. Protect them in all their ways. Strengthen their families and marriages, and let them not grow weary in well doing. Let them KNOW that You are with them.

Day 14 Fire Departments

***Psalm 66:12-13** We went through fire and through water; but You brought us out to rich fulfillment.*

***Isaiah 43:2** When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.*

PRAYER:

Father, we lift up the men and women who serve our county, fighting fires and serving our people in a multitude of ways. We pray a hedge of protection round about them.... And when they walk through the fire, it will not scorch them, because YOU, are in there with them. We ask for divine guidance and help as they risk their lives to help others. Your Word says that greater love has no man, than that he lay his life down for his friend. We pray great blessings over these volunteers and servants.

We praise You and thank You for Your loving care. We lift up the men and women of these fire departments and pray blessings over them and their families. We pray for those involved in Search and Rescue and Water Rescues. Help them to find those who are lost. Give them wisdom where to look and how to help. Make them ministers of Your peace as they care for people in traumatic situations. In Jesus' wonderful name we pray!

It shall be that fishermen will stand by it from En Gedi to En Eglaim; (from the top to the bottom of the county); they will be places for spreading their nets. Their fish will be of the same kinds as the fish of the Great Sea, exceedingly many.*

Matt. 6:10 *Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven;*

Isaiah 60 *—Proclaim it over our land and people!*

PRAYER:

Father, we thank You for the fishing industry in our rivers, bays, and off our coast. Lord, we pray for divine appointments for those who are needing jobs and the employers seeking workers well-suited to their jobs.

Father, for those seeking employment, would You minister hope to their hearts? Lead them to the right employment where their own gifts and

strengths can flourish. Where there has been generational hindrances and fatherlessness, would You heal these areas of brokenness and give these precious ones the strength to contribute to their communities successfully. Restore where they have lost. Heal where they have been broken. Give them employment where their skill-sets allow them to gain confidence and have a sense of well-being in work. Psalm 100:5.

I specifically pray that every person seeking employment has a door of hope opened to them, and that they have the courage to see and accept this gift.

Where there are precious ones who are homeless, dear Father, would You come and meet these ones in the depth of their need. Jesus, they need to know that someone cares. They need to know that You care, Jesus. Would you raise up faith homes, half-way houses, church and government safe places of rest and shelter, where these ones can take refuge and find a caring heart. We pray for an abundance of affordable housing. Jesus, would You assist our city's leadership in really making homelessness a priority. Lord, You said to give a drink of water in Your name is as if it were done to You. Help us to recognize the significance of simple acts of caring. Forgive us for being judgmental. Day 26 Our People

Luke 10:19 *I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.*

Proverbs 2:1-6 *My son, if you will receive my words and treasure my commandments within you, make your ear attentive to wisdom, incline your heart to understanding; For if you cry for discernment, lift your voice*

for understanding; if you seek her as silver and search for her as for hidden treasures; Then you will discern the fear of the LORD and discover the knowledge of God. For the LORD gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.

Psalm 68:6 *God sets the solitary in families;*

- Oregon has the fourth highest divorce rate in the nation.
- Of people who identify as Christians but rarely attend church, 60 percent of these have been divorced.
- Of those who attend church regularly, 38 percent have been divorced.
- Thirty-two percent of children grow up in single parent households.

PRAYER:

Lord, we lift up the families in our State and ask for Your hand of mercy and truth to be poured out. You are our mighty Father, our healer, sustainer, and comforter. Our families need your guidance to know how to raise their children up in the ways of the Lord. Break the generational curses of divorce, addiction, poverty, sexual abuse, perversions of every kind, physical abuse, crime, adultery, hate, and bitterness. Heal the broken hearts of those children who have been affected by these traumas. These same children have grown into adults and still carry the hurt and pain from a broken past. They need to see redemption. Holy Spirit, bring light to the areas they have attempted to keep hidden in the dark. Bring life to where the enemy tried to bring death. We speak life and life abundantly over the families in our communities, state, and around the world. We know that you are faithful to complete a work you started. With healing, we also ask for revelation knowledge of Jesus Christ and an understanding of each person's true identity as a child of the King. We speak the truth of who the Lord says we are over our families. They have an inheritance that cannot be taken away and we ask they will have a renewed confidence of what is rightfully theirs. Pray scriptural truths over families today, that they will be grounded, rooted, and established in who they are in Christ Jesus so that they cannot be shaken and chains are broken.

Pregnant Women: Lord, we thank You for every life that You have created, planned before the foundation of the earth. Each one precious in Your sight. Our hearts are grieved by the numbers of babies being sacrificed by abortion. We pray for the mothers, that You would give wisdom and understanding to Your creative purpose in each life. You chose them in You before the foundation of the world to be holy and without blame before You in Love. These precious children are predestined to adoption as a son by Jesus Christ to Himself. They are accepted in the Beloved. They are received by You to Your glory. They are complete in You.

Elderly: Lord, at a time when our elders need You most, make yourself real to them. Fill their hearts with peace. Comfort those who grieve. We pray protection over each one, as they become more frail, that You would uphold them with your victorious right hand! If they cannot stay at home, we pray that You would go before them and behind them, comfort them as they grieve the loss of independence, help them to make new friends, and prepare the way of the Lord! We pray for every facility, that You would bring in quality staff who care and protect. The facilities are a mission field Lord, for the residents and the staff! Let Your name be exalted. Give boldness to those who know You, to lead each other, even the staff, to Your throne of grace. We seal them with Your word. They are created in

Your image and You knew them before You formed them in their mother's womb. Before they were born they were sanctified and ordained as a prophet to the nations. They are the body of Christ Jesus and a member individually.

Youth: Let the fire of Your Spirit flood our young people with a vision and a hope throughout this state! Give them holy boldness to follow You and to testify of Your greatness. Make them ministers of Your peace and hope and let a spirit of intercession fall on our young people. Plow up the ground of their hearts and make them a fertile field for the planting of the Lord. Raise up righteous young people to be in positions of authority with servant hearts, and leadership skills. Let our future generations be as unto You!

Help them to find You, everywhere they look, Lord. We pray for the children of these families to be trained up in the way they should go. Help single parents to administer consistent, wise discipline. Surround these families with godly men and women to encourage, and provide extended family support. Raise up a standard of protection over the children, from un-godly people, motives, and influences. When single parents go to court, only You know the Truth of their situation. Turn the heart of the judge to protect the children. Defend the weak and the fatherless; uphold the cause of the poor and the oppressed.

Our Children: Lord, we ask that You, would captivate and seal the hearts of our children from a young age. Lead each child by Your Holy Spirit, and bring them to a point of repentance and relationship with You. Train them up in the way they should go, so when they are old they should not depart from it. May they never question that they are justified by faith, have access to peace of mind and faith through grace. PRAYER:

Day 28 Education

***Psalms 135 Vs 11-13** They shall speak of the glory of your kingdom and tell of your power to make known to the children of man, your mighty deeds and the glorious splendor of your kingdom. Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom and your dominion endures throughout all generations...*

***Proverbs 1:1** Their purpose is to teach people wisdom and discipline, to help them understand the insights of the wise.³ Their purpose is to teach people to live disciplined and successful lives, to help them do what is right, just, and fair.⁴ These proverbs will give insight to the simple, knowledge and discernment to the young. Vs 7 Fear of the Lord is the foundation of true knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.*

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, we come before You on behalf of our children and ask that You would guide them into all Truth. You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; We ask that the enemy of our souls restore what he has stolen, and the things which he has extorted. We ask that You would be magnified and exalted in the training up in our children in the way they should go. Day 31 Pray for Those in Authority

Psalms 33:12 "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord".

1Tim.2:1-2 I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone-for Kings and all those in authority; that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all goodness and holiness.

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, we come to you on behalf of our great nation and ask for your hand of mercy and forgiveness to be extended to us, and to our leadership for we have sinned greatly against You, with many decisions which have

made sin legal. We are grieved by this and seek Divine intervention to bring restoration to the laws of our land. We thank You, for those who are willing to serve our nation in a leadership capacity, asking that you bless them with humble, servant-hearted abilities. We pray for the Godly and righteous replacements of new Supreme Court Justices who would seek Your wisdom and righteousness, and who would prevail with strength and discernment.

Day 34 The Military/Law Enforcement

Numbers 10:9 *“When you go into battle in your own land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast on the trumpets. Then you will be remembered by the Lord your God and rescued from your enemies.”*

Deuteronomy 31:6 *“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you.”*

PRAYER:

Father, we come to you calling out for the protection of our men and women who are the frontline of battle and for all those troops and families who prepare the way at home. These are our men and women who stand in our nation between us and chaos.

ancient ruins, they shall raise up the former desolations, they shall repair the ruined cities (nation), the devastation of many generations."

Philippians 4:8 *"Whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things."*

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, we as Americans have immersed ourselves, intentionally or unintentionally, in media of all kinds, unfiltered, untruthful, blasphemous. We are bombarded with demonic imagery wherever we look. Lord, Christians suffer along with non-Christians. I will get up and go to my father, and I will say to him, "I will arise and go to my Father, and I will say to Him, "Father, I (America) have sinned against heaven and before you. I am no longer worthy to be called your (nation)" ...and she arose and came to (her) Father, but while (America) was still a long way off, (her Father) saw her and felt compassion, and ran and embraced (her) and kissed (her). --Paraphrased for the nation

Exhortation:

America, how far you have gone from your first love. This nation was built on the Gospels and God's Law and Principles. Many lives have died defending what God has given to us. Like the Prodigal Son, America has left her first love. America has wasted her inheritance in reckless and immoral living. Gone are the days when America held her head high and honored God. America removed God's Word from the schools. America has redefined marriage. America has said it is alright to kill the unborn. America has legalized drugs and prostitution in our lands. America how far you have strayed and now you are in the pig pen-- now it's time to come to your senses. It is time to acknowledge that you have sinned and call out to God in repentance. Our Heavenly Father is waiting for us. HE is running to you, America, and waiting to embrace you once again. America, you will be restored once again as a great nation and a beacon of hope. As was the prodigal son, so is America. We were once lost but now are found. It is time to celebrate.

Father, we are fully aware that we have become a prodigal nation. We have squandered the foundation laid by our forefathers, a nation established on Your precepts. We have fallen with immorality, perversion, broken covenants and innocent blood shed. As a nation, we have called good things bad and bad things good. We have violated Your Commandments

Day 41 The Peace of Jerusalem

Psalms 122:6 "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you. Peace be within your walls, Prosperity within your palaces."

Genesis 12:3 *I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."*

PRAYER:

Dear Lord Jesus, thank you for your faithfulness! We pray for Jerusalem to experience the peace of God that passes all understanding! Thank You for Your undying love for Your people and for Your land. Thank You for Your people in this land, that there is a living, growing body of the Messiah in Israel, that Jewish people are having their eyes opened to who their Messiah is and some are receiving Him. Lord, we are looking forward to when You will lift the veil fully from the eyes of the Jewish people which has been and is preventing most from recognizing You. Day 42 For the Poor, the Hungry and Downtrodden

Deuteronomy 15:11 For the poor will never cease from the land; therefore, I command you, saying, ‘You shall open your hand wide to your brother, to your poor and your needy, in your land.’

1 John: 3:17 ¹⁶ By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. ¹⁷ But whoever has this world’s goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? ¹⁸ My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.

Facts:

- Two-thirds of the world’s poorest people live in India, China, Nigeria, Bangladesh and the Democratic Republic of Congo and are subsisting on less than \$1.25/day, according to a new World Bank study.
- Almost half the world---over three billion people---live on less than \$2.50 a day.
- The world’s poorest countries could pay 40 percent more for food this year than last year, according to a United Nations report. In those countries, nearly A BILLION people are on the brink of malnourishment and, as food prices climb, more are at risk of starving.

PRAYER:

We pray today for God's people, His creation. We pray that we, as humanity might identify with our human face. We pray for our world divided. God of life, into your world You come. Into this divided human community, You arrive. You sit amongst the poor but the wealthy do not see You. You, walk with the lonely and the abandoned, but those with power cannot hear Your footsteps. You, stand among the hungry crowds awaiting food, but the greedy will not share their food with You. You live among the powerless, the frightened and the weak, but the corrupt fail to notice and continue to exploit You. God of hope, deliver us all from self-righteousness so that while we may call the world towards a different way, we might also become the answer to the prayers of the silent, suffering, and struggling ones. God of justice, grant us the courage to live as well as proclaim Your gospel. God of life, grant us the energy to serve others in Your name. God of love, enable and allow us, with all our weaknesses and fears, to continue this walk of faith, for faith and in faith.

O God, we identify now with those who lack food. Give us (the world) this day, our daily bread. Bring to our awareness those in need. Move on our hearts to share with those who have not, and to weep for those who are downtrodden. We pray for people in war torn countries where corruption has caused control of the food. Matt 7:7-8** Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. **James 4:8; Jeremiah 29:13; Acts 2:17, Matt. 5:6, Jeremiah 33:3

PRAYER:

O Lord...We come, so hungry & thirsty for a move of God. We long to see a fresh, dynamic outpouring of the Holy Spirit across every Nation. O God, awaken the heart and soul of every man, woman and child. May there be a desperate longing to know You, Jesus, and experience an outpouring of Your Holy Spirit in the midst of everyday life. In all Your splendor of Your Holiness, draw the Bride of Christ deeper—deeper into the realms of Your perfect love. Day 44 For Missionaries

Revelation 14:6-7 Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—⁷ saying with a loud voice, “Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.”

PRAYER:

Father, we thank you for the amazing men and women whom You have called to reach every tongue, tribe and every nation in the whole earth. As we pray for all missionaries, we also pray for missionaries that we know or support, _____, that all will be filled with the Holy Spirit and will daily walk in His power and that they will speak the Word of God with boldness. James 1:27 *“Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.”*

Deuteronomy 14:27 *“So that ...the fatherless and the widows who live in your towns may come and eat and be satisfied, and so that the Lord your God may bless you in all the work of your hands”.*

Psalms 68:5-6 *‘A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling. God sets the solitary in families;*

- Total estimated number of orphans worldwide: 150 Million
- Estimated # that have lost only their mother: 34.5 Million
- Estimated # that have lost only their father: 101 Million
- Estimated # of children on streets or in residential care: 2-8 Million
- In India of the 20 million orphans, 99% of them are orphaned by abandonment. According to the Christian Alliance for Orphans 2017
- Nearly 800,000 people are widowed each year in the USA according US Census Bureau estimates
- In 2010, at least 245 million women around the world had been widowed, with more than 115 million of them living in devastating poverty, according to a United Nations report.

PRAYER:

Lord, help us to identify with humanity when we are far removed. It's hard to imagine the circumstances of many of these people. It's difficult to ascertain the uncertainties, difficulties, and hardships they face every day, or the loneliness they feel. Many are vulnerable. Father, we pray for widows and orphans throughout the world. We ask that You, in your great mercy and grace, would meet and heal their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs in a powerful, evident way. We pray for their salvation, if they don't know You, as Jesus prayed that, “they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom Thou hast sent.”

Father, we ask that you bring godly believers into their lives to be ministers of love and good works, full of humility, compassion, and encouragement, to teach them about You, to bless their lives in practical, needed ways. And that these laborers would not grow weary in doing good, but would sense Your favor and equipping. Draw widows and orphans close to You in deep and trusting ways. Replace despair with hope. Replace fears with assurance. Give them physical strength, food, shelter, emotional support and spiritual sustenance. Keep them in your perfect peace. Let them clearly see and acknowledge You at work in their lives. Fill their hearts with reverence, repentance, hope, and trust in You. Help them to turn to You, to petition You in all of their ways. Fill them with Your wisdom. Give them an eternal perspective. Give them a stronger faith, belief and trust in You and a deep assurance of knowing that You are always with them. Lord, we lift up the agencies that minister to populations of widows and orphans and ask for favor from the host countries to let helping agencies in. Help them to find the people who need help most. Lord, we pray that children who need homes and protection would be placed with loving, safe families. We lift up the children who are sold into slavery or human trafficking to be delivered sovereignly into protection. We pray for their healing.

*Lord, open my eyes to see what I, where I am, can do for them. And now, I lift up widows, children who may be in foster care, children of single parents who may need my love and support. Remind me Lord to actually DO to others as I would want done for me. What can I do that might ease the burden? Lord, do You have someone in mind? _____ I am listening. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Day 46 The Persecuted Church

Jeremiah 20:11 *But the Lord is with me as a mighty, awesome One. Therefore my persecutors will stumble, and will not prevail. They will be greatly ashamed, for they will not prosper. Their everlasting confusion will never be forgotten.*

Psalms 9:13 John 15:18 & 20 Romans 8:35

Right now, 200 million people face persecution for believing in Jesus, and 60 percent of those people are children, according to Christians in Crisis International Ministry.

PRAYER:

Sovereign God, we worship You and we acknowledge that You know all of those who suffer in Your name. We remember those who are imprisoned for their faith and ask that they would join with the Apostle Paul to see that even though they remain captive, their chains have furthered the gospel, not frustrated it. May they inspire and embolden their fellow believers to speak the word of God more courageously and fearlessly.

God of all comfort, for those who are tortured both in body and mind, give them the grace to endure and to see their suffering as part of following in Christ's footsteps. Merciful God, for those asked to pay the ultimate price; may they truly know Christ and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death.

Father God, for those who are widowed and orphaned may they know the comfort that comes from Your promised presence even when they walk through the valley. May they be strengthened by Your Spirit, enabling them to rejoice with the psalmist as they proclaim that the Lord will not abandon them in death.

Heavenly Father, we ask that You make us ever mindful of our brothers and sisters around the world who need us to stand with them as they suffer in Your name. Teach us what it means to overcome by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of our testimony; we pray that we would not love our lives so much as to shrink from death.

O Lord, hear our prayer. Lord have mercy on our brothers and sisters in Christ, may we be aware of the situation they are facing and to never forget them in prayer, or in any other way we can be of help to them. May You send them angels from heaven to comfort them and assure them of Your constant care and love!!

*And now, Lord, in my own life and faith, help me to endure persecution with faith and grace. Help my soft answers to turn away wrath. Help me

to be strong and of good courage. Help me to bless and pray for my persecutors and for those I know who are undergoing persecution. Let me not shrink away in fear, but let me face my persecutors with gentleness, courage, and even love. In the Name of Jesus Christ we pray. Amen

Day 47 Protection From Evil

Romans 8:35-39 *We are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

2 Timothy 1:7; Psalm 91:1-16; Psalm 27:1

PRAYER:

O Lord, as we walk in the midst of troubled times, shield, protect and strengthen the Body of Christ throughout the world from the evil one. Let our faith arise even in the midst of all the turmoil! For You have not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind....You, promise to never leave us nor forsake us. Therefore, when darkness surrounds us, let us boldly confess "The Lord is My Helper; whom shall I fear?" Lord we look to You...A Strong Tower of Refuge, Our Rock; Our Shield, and the Horn of our Salvation, Our Savior...Our Deliverer...You are the Resurrection of Life! You are our Hiding Place; You preserve us from trouble; and surround us with songs of deliverance. Remind us Lord that we as humans are no match for the enemy...our help must come from the Lord! Therefore, when darkness surrounds us, let us be quick to call upon the name of the Lord...Our Defender...Our protection...Our Faithful God, in whom we trust!

May the Body of Christ hear Your call to prepare for battle...To arise to their rightful place with a dynamic holy boldness! May we stand firm on the Holy Word as we face adversity and not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday...!! O God, empower your people to be strong in the Lord, and fully trust Your Holy Word...For you have provided the weapons to demolish strongholds through Your word and the

spirit-empowered prayer! Remind us to daily put on the whole armor of God, that we may be able to stand against the devil's schemes...for we know we wrestle not against flesh and blood,...Therefore, prompt us to put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, we may be able to stand our ground, praying for one another!

Bless the Lord O my soul.... For You never sleep nor slumber... You are constantly watching and caring for Your people! — Keeping us from all harm— You will forever keep guard over our lives...our coming and going, both now and forevermore. With God as our Defender.... who can be against us?

*And now, Lord, I submit areas of my life to You that cause me fear and anxiety, and I repent for entertaining them. I confess them as faithlessness. They are _____. You have given me Your Word to overcome ALL the power of the evil one, even in my own mind. Today, I lay my fears at Your throne of grace. Help me to walk free from these, and leave them with You. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit and Faith to walk boldly and in victory over ALL these things. In Jesus Name! Amen!

Day 48 Wars and Rumors of Wars

Matthew 24:6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

Isaiah 16:3-5; Psalm 91

PRAYER:

Lord, we thank you that You are Lord over all the Earth and that Your ways are higher than our ways. Our hearts grieve when we hear about tribe against tribe, and nation against nation. And our hearts are heavy when our nation is at war. But we stand with You, Lord God Almighty, and we pray that the nations will bow their knees to You, and hear Your voice. We pray the nations of the earth will rise up in righteousness to bring liberty to the captives and peace to war torn lands. We grieve over evil rulers in the world and the demonic influence that causes hate, discontent, and domination. As we read Your Word, we know that throughout the ages there have been evil kings and good kings. What made a good king was that they loved and honored You. The evil kings worshiped other gods, greedy and oppressed their people. Lord, we stand in the gap for those tribes and nations who are at war, and we pray for wisdom and godliness to prevail and indeed, that those godless nations would be overcome by the word of our testimony, the blood of the Lamb and by not loving our lives unto death. That You would overcome great darkness with divine light. That You would cause goodness and mercy to prevail.

We pray for people groups, families and individuals who attempt to escape war torn areas and persecution. Provide them a way of escape. Expose things hidden in darkness for the protection of all the refugees and the helpers and deliver them from the hand of the evil one. We ask that You prepare the way and remove red tape for godly organizations who will bring the help and resources required for day to day, but also that they would bring a powerful gospel message that would touch the hearts of refugees. We pray for absolute revival to run like wild-fire through refugee camps, and they would become places of discipleship, hope and strength. We pray for those ministering in refugee camps that You would protect and prepare them to minister the gospel powerfully to those in need. We

pray for signs and wonders and miracles to be released in a mighty move of God. We pray for removal of godless leaders where tyranny, corruption and oppression have prevailed. Have mercy, Lord. Bring restoration. Turn the hearts of kings toward You, and restore righteousness.

*And now Lord, what country would You like me to pray for, and how would You like me to pray. I am listening. _____ In Jesus Name, Amen

Day 49 Strengthen the Body of Christ

Isaiah 61:1-2 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion—to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of his splendor.

Ephesians 3:15-20; Colossians 1:9-11; Isaiah 58:6-7; Isaiah 1:17; Hebrews 13:21

PRAYER:

Lord, we lift up the Body of Christ around the world and pray that out of Your glorious riches she may be strengthened with power from on High. We pray for each church corporately and individually, and each Christian, to be rooted and established in love. May we begin to grasp how wide, how long, how high and deep is the love of Christ, a love that surpasses all knowledge. May our churches and people be filled with wisdom, guidance and understanding, so that we may live lives worthy of the Lord. May we be pleasing to You in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in Truth and the knowledge of God. Let us stand solidly upon your Holy Word, for it is right and true and let us never stop praying for one another!

Lord, let the churches of the earth be filled with strength, endurance, and patience with a heart filled with love, understanding and encouragement. Help us to live in complete harmony with each other and always be ready to be a father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, feed the hungry and clothe those in need. May we shine the Light of Life into the darkened world, preaching the Good news to the poor; bind up the brokenhearted, and proclaim freedom to the captives; release prisoners from darkness and comfort those who mourn. May we be faithful to Shepard our flocks, work our fields and vineyards....Oh that we may be called Oaks of righteousness displaying Your Splendor!

O God, instruct the churches and your people, and teach us in the way we should go. Gently guide us with Your eye. May Your Word be a lamp unto our feet and a light unto our path. Faithfully equip us Lord, with every good thing needed for doing Your will. We surrender our hearts...Do Your work in us, preparing us for what is pleasing to You. Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within the churches throughout the earth and in our own heart, to Christ Jesus be all glory and Honor...throughout all generations for ever more!

Day 50 Growth of the Church

Matt 28:18-20 *And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.*
