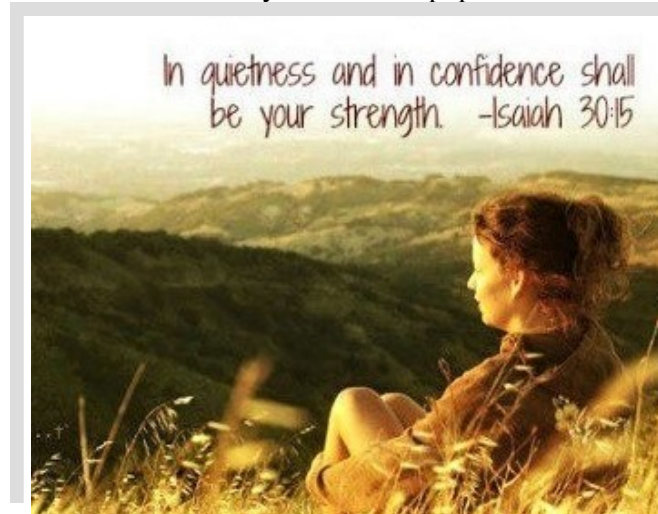
Those Trying Times
